All Emails received will be read aloud during the Public Comment portion of the agenda. Emails should be kept to under 200 words to allow time for others to be heard and for the Board to progress through the public meeting agenda. The Board typically does not immediately respond to public comments or engage in open dialogue, but the Board is actively listening to all comments.
