



Lincolnwood Parks and Recreation Department Park and Athletic Field Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations apply specifically to the general use of parks, athletic fields and picnics. In addition, parks and playground users shall abide by all ordinances and regulations as officially adopted by the Village Board of Trustees, either published or posted. The Village reserves the right to change these rules at any time.

1. All individuals and organizations using the recreational facilities of the Village shall obey the posted and written rules and ordinances governing their use.
2. All individuals and organizations issued park permits must be able to show their copy upon request.
3. Organizations sponsoring programs for minors must provide adult supervision during activities.
4. All equipment and facilities shall be properly cleaned and all damage or loss reported and replaced.
5. All paper, debris, bottles and garbage must be collected and deposited in the containers furnished for that purpose.
6. No person shall drive any electric, gas, or battery operated vehicle, with the exception of wheelchairs or equivalent personal mobility devices for the disabled on any paved roads or parking areas unless other areas are specifically designated as temporary parking areas by the Village.
7. No person shall bring into any public park nor shall any person possess or consume any alcoholic beverages or drugs upon said premises. No person shall be under the influence of alcohol or drugs while in or upon any public park.
8. No person shall have been responsible for the entry of a dog, cat, horse or other domestic, agricultural or wild animal into any portion of a public park including the playground area.
9. The use of fireplaces, picnic tables, bleachers and any other publicly used facility within the parks and playgrounds are provided on a first-come, first-served basis, unless reserved by permit issued by the Parks and Recreation Department located inside Village Hall.
10. No person shall, without permit, display or offer for sale any article or thing, nor shall solicit contributions for any purpose whether public or private.
11. Fires/cooking will only be permitted in Proesel Park in areas designated for that purpose. This pertains to the area around, not inside, the shelter house. All fires shall be completely extinguished before leaving the area.
12. Any use of loud speakers, public address systems, musical instruments, radios or other devices causing considerable noise may only be used with the expressed written permission of the Parks and Recreation Department.
13. Picnic, general grounds and athletic field permits shall not begin before 10:00am nor be later than 10:00pm except by special written permission.
14. No person shall displace, remove or alter any facility or grounds on park property without written permission of the Parks and Recreation Department.
15. No golf playing is permitted.
16. Any unnecessary littering, noise, disorder, or violation of any ordinance or regulations of the Village shall be deemed just cause for immediate voiding of a permit, and may be cause for future denial of a permit and/or arrest by an officer of the Village.
17. No person shall take part in or abet the playing of any games involving thrown or otherwise propelled objects

such as balls, arrows, javelins, or model airplanes, except in areas set apart for such forms of recreation. The playing of rough or comparatively dangerous games such as football, baseball or quoits (using discs) is prohibited except on the fields and courts or areas provided therefor. Roller-skating, skateboarding and in-line skating is prohibited on the basketball courts, tennis courts and playground area of any public park except when part of a Parks and Recreation Department program.

18. No person shall ride a bicycle in an area or on a surface within any public park other than a paved vehicular road or path designated for that purpose. A bicyclist shall be permitted to wheel or push a bicycle by hand over any grassy area or wooded trail on any paved area reserved for pedestrian use.
19. No person shall erect any structure, tent or shelter of any kind without permission from the Parks and Recreation Department.
20. No person shall park a vehicle in an area or on a surface other than in established or designated parking areas and such use shall be in accordance with the posted directions and/or the instructions of any attendant who may be present.
21. Persons without a park permit shall not use park facilities for any unreasonable time if the facilities are crowded. No person shall leave a picnic area before the fire is completely extinguished and before all refuse and garbage is placed in waste receptacles. If no such waste receptacles are readily available, such refuse and garbage shall be carried away from the park area and properly disposed of.
22. No person shall swim, bathe or wade in any waters or waterways in or adjacent to any public park, except in such areas as are designated for swimming, and in compliance with the rules adopted by the Parks and Recreation Department.
23. No person shall pollute the air or water nor shall any person litter in any public park.
24. No person shall announce, advertise or call the public attention in any way to any article or service for sale or hire. No person shall post any sign, placard or advertisement in, on or adjacent to any public park.
25. No person or persons shall act in such a manner as to interfere with another person or persons' proper use of any park or recreational facility. Persons to whom park permits have been issued and persons participating in Village recreational programs have priority in the use of the park areas and facilities during the time for which such park permits are issued or such recreational programs are scheduled. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to interfere with any permittees or any person participating in a Parks and Recreation Department program.
