

NOTICE OF EXPUNGEMENT

Public Act 101-0027, known as the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act (CRTA), became law on June 25, 2019. The CRTA deemed a "Minor Cannabis Offense" eligible for expungement. "Minor Cannabis Offense" is defined as follows in Section 5.2 of the Criminal Identification Act:

"Minor Cannabis Offense" means a violation of Section 4 or 5 of the Cannabis Control Act concerning not more than 30 grams of any substance containing cannabis, provided the violation did not include a penalty enhancement under Section 7 of the Cannabis Control Act and is not associated with an arrest, conviction or other disposition for a violent crime as defined in subsection (c) of Section 3 of the Rights of Crime Victims and Witnesses Act."

Pursuant to the Criminal Identification Act all law enforcement agencies within the State are required to automatically expunge all non-conviction "Minor Cannabis Offense" criminal history records of arrest within specific time parameters.

In Accordance with Public Act 101-0027, public notice is hereby given that the Lincolnwood Police Department has automatically expunged all qualifying "Minor Cannabis Offense" records created between January 1, 2013 and June 25, 2019.
